On <u>Tuesdays</u>, <u>Wednesdays</u>, <u>and Thursdays</u> for the next few weeks, Higher Ground will be handing out to-go boxes of food from <u>12:00 to 1:00</u>. All meals are to-go and the house will be LOCKED.

It's a scary time—one that I'm not feeling very comfortable with at all—and I know that a lot of people at Higher Ground are scared right now, but I know without a doubt that the love here will **not recede**. Technically, the house will have to pause in its role as a place for people to spend time with each other and engage in fellowship, but in its new modification it will become more of a resource center and a site of emergency emotional counseling.
